

- Shuttle transport will be provided for FAI/ISC officials only, between hotel and tunnel.
- FAI and ISC officials will be accommodated at Hôtel Kyriad Aix les Milles Address: Plan de campagne, 79 Rte de Rans, 13320 Bouc-Bel-Air (3 minutes by car from our facilities)
- Judges travelling by train will be picked up at Aix en Provence TGV station.
- Judges traveling by plane will be picked up at Marseille Provence Airport
- The organiser takes in charge transportation between TGV station or Marseille Provence Airport only, depending on the arrival schedule coordinated by the chief judge.

^{**}A Sanction fee will be paid to the ISC by all registered person listed on an Official Entry Form. According to The FAI Sporting Code Section 5 point 4.1.3, the amount per person is determined by the ISC plenary in the year in which FCE takes place.

Competitors entry fee includes:

Registration:

A valid 2026 FAI Sporting License is required and must be obtained through the competitor's NAC (National Airsport Control). All competitors must be registered by their NAC before completing the registration process with the Organizer.

*NOTE to NACs:

The name of competitors on the entry form must be EXACTLY the same as the one listed in the FAI Sporting License Database.

Please use the FAI ID Number NOT the NAC License number.

PROVISIONAL ENTRY (FOR NACS)

Each NAC will receive a secure PDF form to fill out with information regarding the teams representing their respective country, such as:

- NAC Contact Information
- Number of person/teams in each event/category. *

^{**} In the case of late entries: Entries after the deadline will be approved only if capacity allows.

- Name and birthdate of each team member.
- Name of team captain + his/her contact information.
- FAI sporting license numbers for each team member
- Indication of team members participating in more than one event.
- Indication if the NAC is paying for the delegations or if teams pay
- Bank transfer only
- Food restrictions
- T-Shirt size

Once the form is complete with the information above, NAC representatives will close the entry and make it official by affixing their seal. The Organizer will then receive the official entry and have the necessary information to contact all team captains to finalize the registration process.

*Please note that only NAC representatives can change the number of teams or team members registered.

Deadline for provisional entry: January 12, 2026

FINAL ENTRY (FOR TEAM/COMPETITORS)

Based on the information transferred by the NACs, each team captain will receive a secure PDF registration form by email and will be required to submit additional details to the Organizer, proof of bank transfer (if the registration fees haven't already been paid by the NAC) and team members' contact details and t-shirt size.

The invoice confirming the payment will be sent to the team captain within asap of receiving their registration form.

Deadline for final submission: February 15th, 2026

Late entries fees: Entries after the deadline will be approved only if capacity allows, and subject to 50 €/participant

- Anti-doping control may be conducted at any time

14 Insurance and National Regulations

- FFP civil liability insurance included in the entry fee
- Each participant must hold their own personal medical and repatriation insurance
- Proof of insurance coverage must be provided to the organizer before the event starts by a signed statement of the registering NAC
- Proof of approval by a parent is required by National law for under age of 18 year old competitors before the event starts. This is provided by a signed statement of the registering NAC to the organizer.
